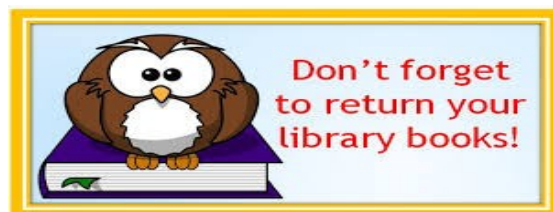

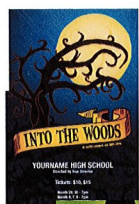

Expression of Interest: Social Skills Groups

Interhealth will be running a number of social skills groups in the July school holidays.

- Preschool group.
- Infants group (Kindy-Year 2).
- Upper primary group (Years 3-6).
- An adolescent "Gaming group" for ages 12-17years.



Social Skill groups provide children and adolescents with the opportunity to explore, learn and practice social and pragmatic language skills in a small group environment. The group will be facilitated by a speech pathologist and/or occupational therapist and involve sharing stories, brainstorming, role play, games and practice.

The groups will cover a range of topics according to age and the participants' goals including:

- Making friends and positively interacting with peers.
- Understanding and managing emotions.
- Recognising social cues of others.
- Acknowledging and responding to others feelings.
- Starting and ending interactions appropriately.
- Problem solving and repairing challenging interactions.
- Understanding turn taking.
- Managing losing, negative outcomes and worries.
- Developing self-responsibility.

The group will run daily for 5 sessions from July 16th-20th during school holidays, with view to have another after school group program during school term. Proposed times are as follows:

- Morning sessions
 - Preschool years – infants
 - Upper primary school.
- Afternoon sessions
 - Adolescent 'Gaming group' for ages 12-17years.
