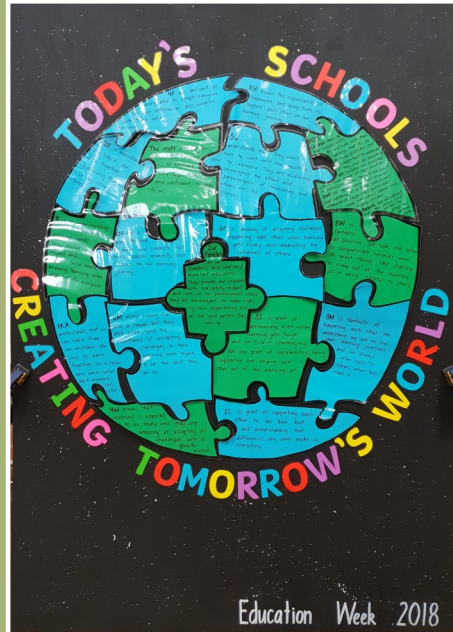
Broken Hill Athletics Carnival
