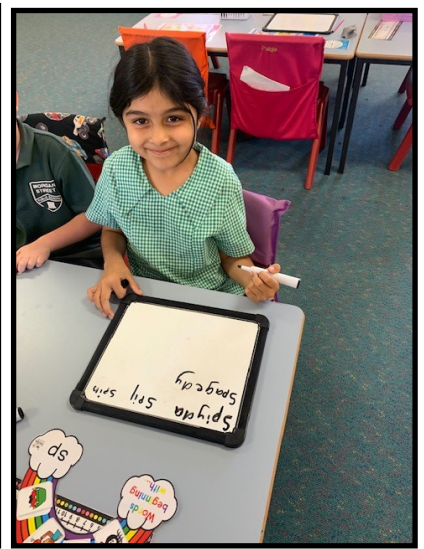
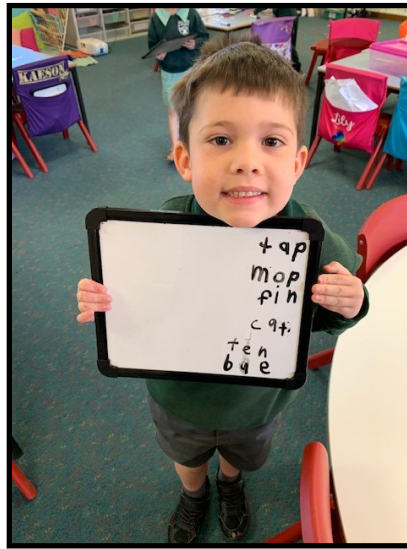

RFF teacher across both ends of our school.

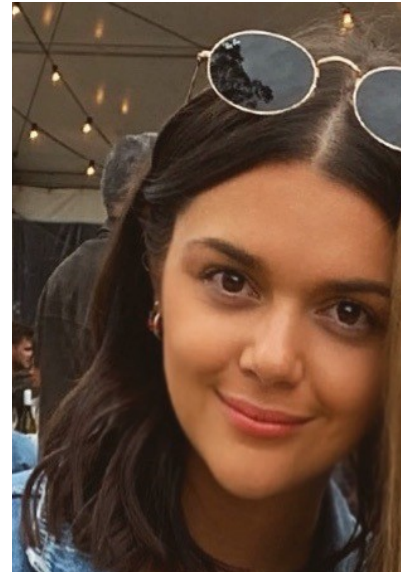
How long have you worked at MSPS?
