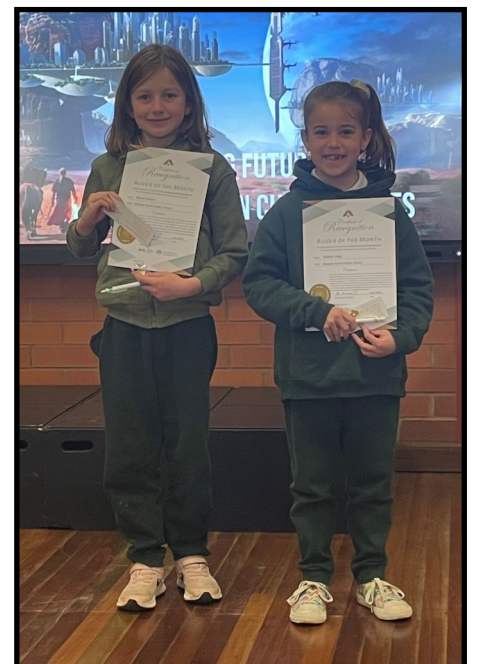
Aussie of the Month
