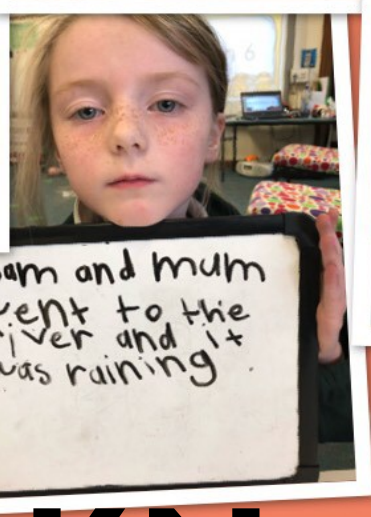
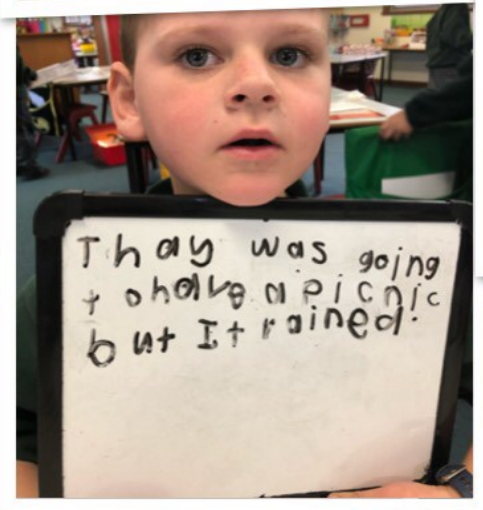
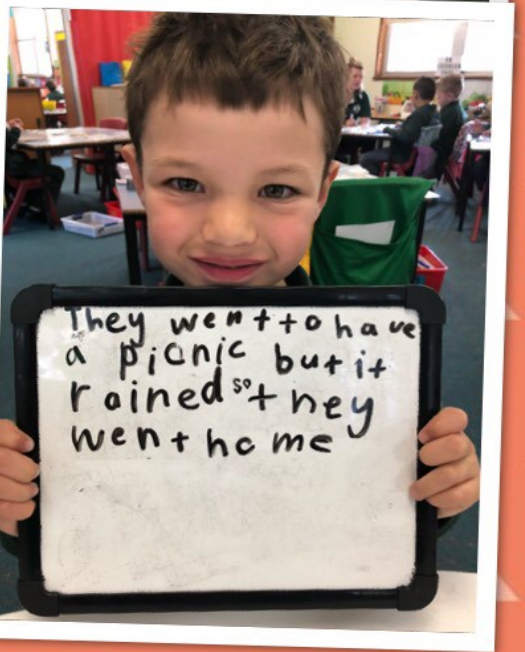
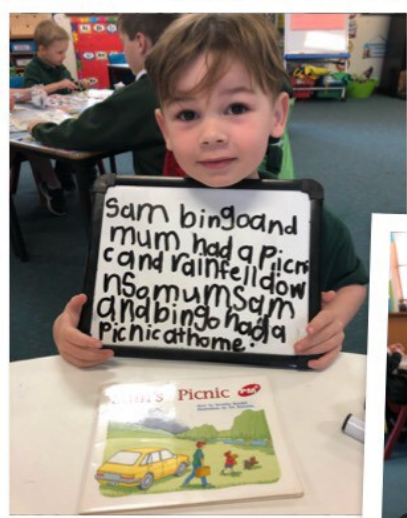
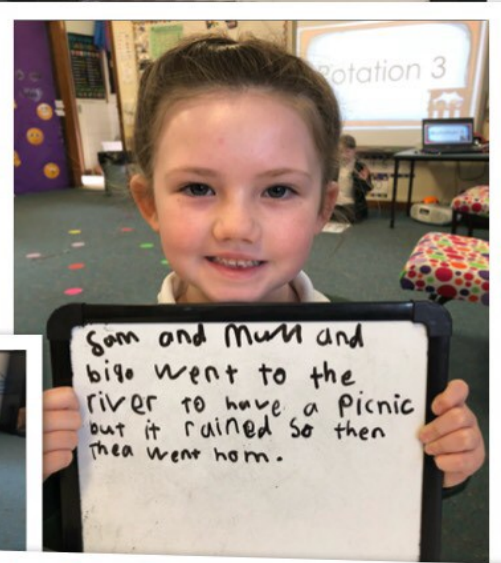
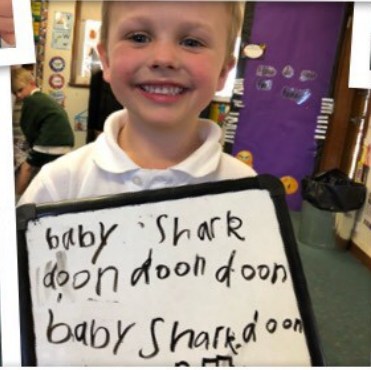
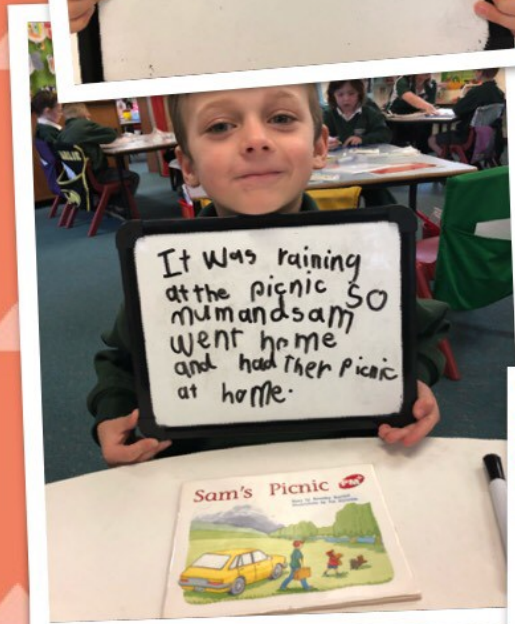
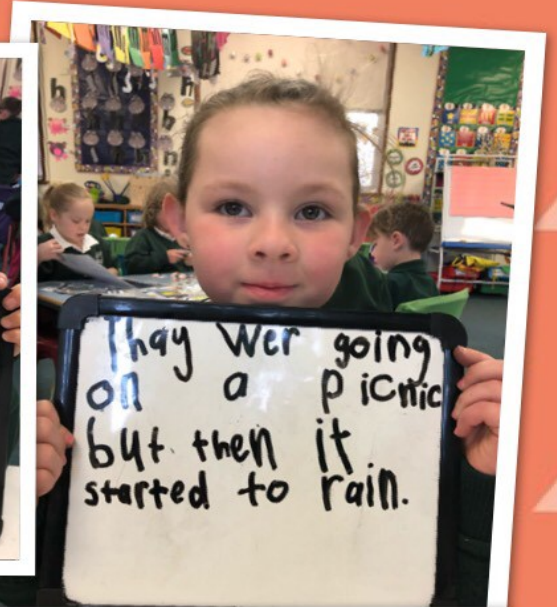
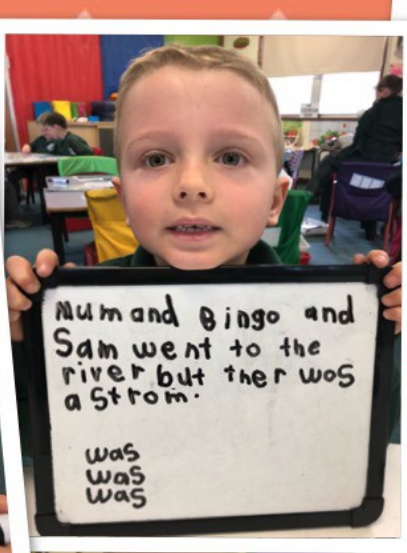
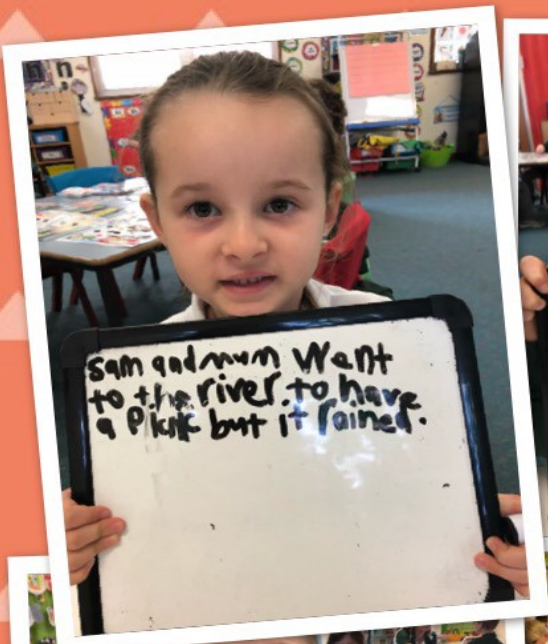
PROUD NEWS

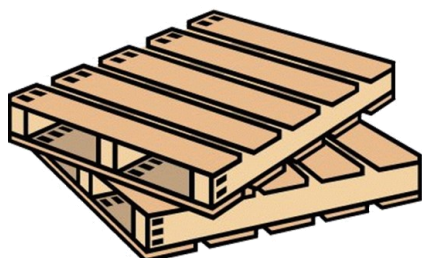
WANTED Wooden Pallets
