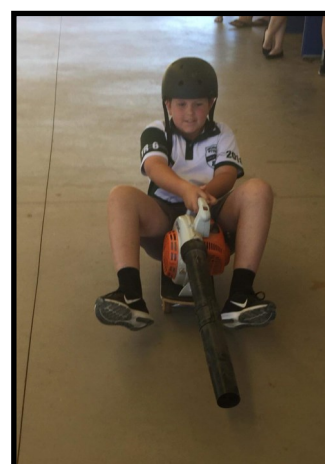

## PROUD NEWS

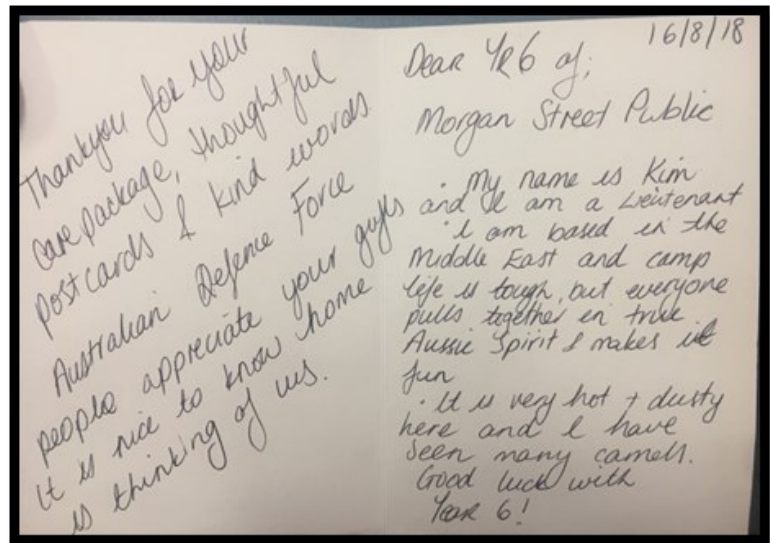
